While the program has changed and evolved over the years to keep up with the times, NSAC at its core has remained the same: to challenge the Filipino youth to create art and to give them the platform to amplify their artistic voice and vision. Following this tradition, the longest-running art competition in the country has proven time and again to be a valuable opportunity for student artists, helping them tap into their full potential and opening doors for bright futures in the field.

Since it was first held in 1951, NSAC has become greater than anyone ever imagined, reaching more schools every year and inspiring thousands of students to use art to build the nation and effect change.

Now, after decades of success and a strong legacy carried forth by countless locally and internationally renowned artists, Shell has decided to take the next step forward. Through the 54th run of the competition, Pilipinas Shell ushered in JUAN ART NATION: an all-encompassing movement that aims to recognize, unite, and empower Filipino artists. Rooted in the Bayanihan spirit, it seeks to build a community that grows together, advocating for art and culture in the Philippines through a variety of plans and programs that will be implemented all over the country.

With the launch of Juan Art Nation, Shell has lit a torch for Filipino artists of all ages: lighting the way and guiding them to where they need to grow and flourish, so they may create art that can move mountains and shape tomorrow.

We are proud to provide them the space to accomplish this, and we make sure we help them grow as artists by choosing compelling themes that spark creative interpretation.

This year's theme "RESTART" asks our student artists to create art that can inspire change, new beginnings, and hope. After all, in a world still struggling with the effects of the pandemic, who better than the resilient youth to show us how to pick ourselves up and keep pushing onward?

They do not disappoint. We see the myriad ways the theme was reflected into art from participating artists all over the country, and we marvel at the forward-thinking minds and compassionate hearts behind them.

We intend to further nurture these traits alongside their artistry through Juan Art Nation – the next chapter of NSAC's story. Juan Art Nation is a campaign, a community, a movement – everything it needs to be to unite and empower Filipino artists as well as advocate art and culture to the general public. With its more wide-reaching initiatives, we can take the arts straight to the people, generating more interest in our shared culture and heritage.
